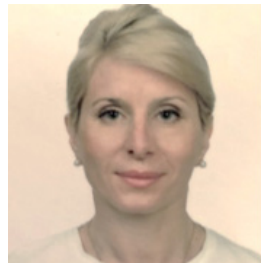


Transnational NGO Initiative

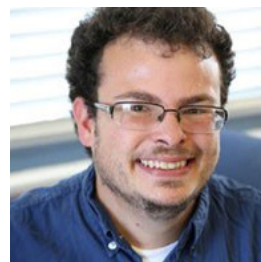
