Standard Bath Chair

- User must have good static and dynamic sitting balance
- No arm rests, must be able to perform sit to stand transfer independently or with assist they have available (if safe)
- Would still need to step over tub to sit in this chair
- Weight Capacity is 400 pounds
- Seat height 15.5"- 19.5"
- Seat dimensions 19.25" (W) x 11.5" (D)
- Other versions of this chair available, with arms rests and padding (more difficult to get insurance to cover)

Standard Transfer Tub Bench

- Allows user to sit on bench on the outside of the tub and scoot over to the inside of the tub
- Grab bar can go on either side of bench
- User should still have good static and dynamic sitting balance
- Consider skin integrity with scooting across bench
- Weight Capacity is 400 pounds
- Seat height 17.5"- 22.5"
- Seat dimensions 26" (W) x 18.5" 19.5" (D)
- Other versions of this bench available, with padding or combination with commode (more difficult to get insurance to cover)

- Shower stand (for roll in shower)
- Offers multiple accessories and supports
- Chair is easily adjustable

- Can get a wheeled shower base for roll in showers and an additional tub stand
- Comes with multiple accessories for safe bathing

HTS Hygeine and Toileting System

- Can be used for toileting and bathing (only with a roll in shower!)
- Consider this type of chair if the user performs a bowel management program that might require them to sit over a toilet for extended periods.
- Can be attached to a toilet or on a mobility base with or without a commode
- Multiple supports available for head, trunk and LE positioning
- User can be positioned in the most optimal way for toileting.
- Waterproof foam padding
- Max user height 74 inches and max user weight approximately 250 pounds
- Max user weight to utilize foot board for transfers is 150 pounds
