- Access to toll-free work incentives assistance to answer a range of questions related to benefits and work 1-888-224-3272
- Access to healthcare through the Medicaid Buy-In for Working People with Disabilities including racial and ethnic minorities
- Access to 100 new Work Incentives Counselors statewide
- Access to improved job training and placement services and services to start your own business
- Strategies to increase your assets including tax refunds through the Earned Income Tax Credit

### If You Are An Employment Service Provider

- Share information about effective practices through an annual Employment and Economic Summit, Regional Learning Communities, print products and issues briefs
- Build partnerships to align disability services, workforce and economic development efforts
- Learn evidence-based practice and participate in model communities of practice to build employer and service provider capacities to improve employment outcomes;
- Participate as a member of the statewide Work Incentives Information Network (WIIN) with a network of in-person and distance learning training programs
- Learn and apply approaches and innovations leading to increased self-employment for New Yorkers with disabilities
