








Career Exploration

Soft Skills Overview

"Hard Skills"

- Specific knowledge and abilities required for success on the job
- Can easily be measured/evaluated

Examples

- Computer skills
- Math skills
- Ability to speak a foreign language



"Soft Skills"

- Can't really be taught in the classroom, on the job, etc.
- Can not be easily measured/evaluated

Examples

- Communication skills
- Leadership skills
- Decision-making skills






If you were an employer, what kinds of skills would you want your employees to have (or not have?!)?




What Do Employers Want?
